The unique position of students who look at the world with fresh eyes and come up with innovative solutions to the problems we face today.

To solve the big problems of modern society and nature we need things changed. How to address problems and solve them? We need the fresh look of the new generations to form new creative solutions! Teach youngsters how to address issues and trigger active citizenship and they will come up with new creative solutions. By developing intercultural skills and a good level of English it will be possible to address European problems too.

The project "SUPERHEROES" aims to create more awareness of what Sustainable Development Goals (SDG's) are and what youngsters themselves can do to contribute to the goals by translating them into more local sustainable goals. By new means of studying like storytelling students learn to address problems. By doing so they are trained to address bigger problems in Europe.

Student for example will learn to tell stories but they also learn to form opinions and share them, to work with students from other countries and will practise their English.

During the upcoming two years (1.03.2022 to 29.02.2024) six partner organisations from four European countries will work together to develop this sustainable programme which is meant for students aged 12 to 16 years and their teachers to change their mindset to take real action in a sustainable world.

The partners (<u>Eolas</u> from Spain, <u>Stichting Aeres Groep</u>, <u>Laptify</u>, and <u>INQ</u> from The Netherlands, <u>PGAZ</u> from Bulgaria and <u>GRUND</u> from Latvia) will create an easy to implement programme. To make sure the programme is easy to use and implement partners will also develop an E-book, a platform and actions plans.

The project addresses the priorities of common values, civic engagement, the development of key competences and the priority of environment and fight against climate change. Due to the different working methods of schools the lesson plan will be divided in four topics and in action plans that will make it very easy for teachers to use it in their own classrooms.

With SUPERHEROES partners want to increase the knowledge of environmental and social issues among youngsters by increasing awareness on environmental and social issues both regional and across Europe.

Of course all materials will be tested thoroughly by the partners and target audiences in the participating countries.
